
EXCEEDS OPPORTUNITY:

Measure your reaction time.

Turn in your measurement and calculations on a piece of scrap paper.

1. Have someone hold a ruler as shown. Make sure your fingers are even with the bottom of the ruler.

- 2. When the other person drops the ruler, grab it as quickly as you can. FOR A FAIR TEST, DO NOT GRAB EARLY.
- 3. Measure the number of centimeters that dropped before you grabbed it.
- 4. Convert those centimeters to meters (divide by 100.)
- 5. Use the distance equation to calculate your reaction time.
