Acceptable



Collaborating on worksheets and problems, but working through your own.

Collaborating on lab reports, but using your own wording.

Helping or tutoring others who are having trouble understanding.

Comparing answers with another student to see if you are on the right track.

Unacceptable



Copying answers or helping others on any benchmark assessment or quiz.

Copying problems from another student while substituting in your own numbers.

Figuring out answers for another student or giving answers to another student.

Doing another student's work.

Cutting and pasting part or all of a lab report, even if you intend to change the wording.

Giving someone else a digital copy of your work, no matter what assurances that person gives you about how they will use it. If any part of your work ends up in someone else's work, you may also be held liable.
